Character Descriptions:

Jane – She is regular and a good sport, an avid reader of mystery stories. Comfortable and practical.

Freida – She is bohemian in her appearance and fancies herself an intellectual. The other girls kid her considerably, but she can give it back to them just as readily.

<u>Alice</u> – Pretty, petite, and feminine, with none of the studied sophistication so characteristic of modern co-eds.

<u>Mary</u> – She is pretty, graceful, and sinuous; she displays no hint of her plebeian background.

Eve – She is a blue-blood and a debutante, but there is nothing upstage or high hat about her. She is genuinely fond of Mary, and takes special interest in her.

Sharon (**Glamorpuss**) – Her nickname bespeaks her character. She speaks with an accent which – she fondly hopes – if the finest Bostonian. She fancies herself quite an actress.

Stella (**Shotput**) – She is the horsy, athletic type. She arrives with miscellaneous sports equipment.

Shirley – One of the freshmen "pledges." She is correspondingly cute with an energy that is apparently inexhaustible.

Betty (**Tennessee**) * - One of the freshmen "pledges." She has a marked southern accent. Immature in comparison to the older girls.

Phyllis* – An upcoming president of the sorority who is viewing the cabin 3 years after events of our play. She only appears in the prologue.
